SCC Golf Guest Policy

Effective October 1, 2006, any member who does not sign their golf guest in at the pro shop and pay guest fees will be charged double fees on their account and be taken to the Board for disciplinary action. No guest are allowed on Monday unless prior arrangements are made.

SCC Late Payment Policy

All statements are due upon receipt and are considered past due on the 20th of each month. A grace period will exist after the 20th until the end of that month. Those bills not paid by the end of the month will be assessed a \$25 late charge and considered 30 days past due. If the bill remains unpaid the following month, the bill will be considered 60 days past due and assessed \$50 in addition to the previous month's \$25 for a total of \$75. All club privileges will be revoked at that point. Membership termination and forfeiture of club stock, if applicable, will be enforced at 90 days past due.

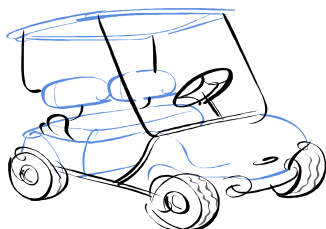

Recipe of the Month

Game Time Maple-and-Balsamic-Glazed Pork Chops with Mango Relish Recipe

- 1 C. maple syrup
- 1/2 C. balsamic vinegar
- 2 ripe mangoes, peeled and diced
- 1 medium red onion, diced (about 1/2 cup)
- 1/2 t. crushed red chiles
- 1 t. sugar
- 1/4 C. chopped chives
- 2 T. rice wine or white wine vinegar
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 4 pork chops (about 10 oz. each)

Combine syrup and balsamic vinegar in saucepan and reduce over medium heat about 20 minutes, or until it coats back of a spoon. This can be prepared up to 1 week before tailgating.

Combine mangoes, onion, chiles, sugar, chives, rice wine or white wine vinegar, and salt and pepper. Refrigerate. This relish can be prepared the day before tailgating.

At ballpark, grill pork chops for 15 to 20 minutes over high heat. In last 5 minutes, brush each side of pork chops with the glaze.

Serve with mango relish. Makes 4 servings.
