## **SCC Late Payment Policy**

All statements are due upon receipt and are considered past due on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. A grace period will exist after the 20<sup>th</sup> until the end of that month. Those bills not paid by the end of the month will be assessed a \$25 late charge and considered 30 days past due. If the bill remains unpaid the following month, the bill will be considered 60 days past due and assessed \$50 in addition to the previous month's \$25 for a total of \$75. All club privileges will be revoked at that point. Membership termination and forfeiture of club stock, if applicable, will be enforced at 90 days past due.

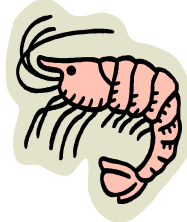

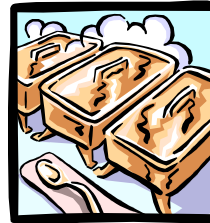
