LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hope everyone had a Happy Halloween and is looking to Thanksgiving and the Holiday Season. As we move into Fall and the Holiday Season, there are a number of exciting activities planned at the Club. I hope that all of you will review the calendar and join us for fun and fellowship this month.

On the golf front:

- The Board met on October 31 to approve plans to start construction of new cart sheds to replace the old community golf shed destroyed by the storm. The old building was insured for its replacement value, but it is going to require additional funds to build a replacement structure in keeping with our needs. Financing has been arranged to cover the additional funds needed and hopefully, the construction contract will be signed and construction started by the middle of the month. Scott will be staying in touch with all of the affected members to keep them informed as to the “what and when” of our recovery plans.
- There has not been a better time to play golf this year than now. The course is in great condition. The weather is comfortable and inviting. It just doesn't get any better than this.
- The cart path reconstruction on holes 1, 2, 3 & 8 is finished (The contractor is due back to fix a few problem areas before bad weather). There is some dirt work to be completed to smooth the transition from the paths to the ground which should be completed in the next few weeks.
- A special “Thank You” to Jeremy and Larry Tabor for the topsoil to enable us to make a few needed improvements to the dirt work on the golf course and to the backside of Number 16.
- The restroom on Number 13 is now in operation and will remain open until cold weather forces us to cut off the water supply. If you find this facility in need of cleaning, please let the pro shop staff know. I encourage all golfers to help us keep this facility presentable for all of us to use.
