Deadline for Match Play Tournament is Wednesday, September 26, 2007 @ 6PM.

It is very important that anyone interested in playing in this tournament sign up quickly. It is also important that there be an even number of 6-man flights. For this reason, if you are not signed up by Wednesday, September 26, 2007 @ 6PM, we cannot guarantee a spot for you in the tournament. Anyone signing up after the 26th will be placed on a waiting list for any available slots in the tournament.

No-Shows, Withdrawals, & Cancellations can cause problems with the tournament pairings. Please make every effort to plan on playing on both Saturday & Sunday of the tournament if you sign up.

\$100 Pro Shop Gift certificate will be given away as a door prize on Sunday, during the Shootout. You do not have to be in the tournament to be eligible for the door prize; However YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN. (Shootout is scheduled to start at approximately 5PM Sunday)

Starkville Country Club has invested in landscaping Holes 15, 16 & 17. If you have not seen the improvements, please take notice. To protect these newly planted areas, you **MUST** use the **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** rule when your ball comes to rest in these mulched beds. If your ball or stance is touching the mulch, you **MUST** take relief.

Relief Procedure: The player must lift the ball and drop it without penalty within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief. The nearest point of relief must not be in a hazard or on a putting green. When the ball is dropped within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, the ball must first strike a part of the course at a spot that avoids interference by the condition and is not in a hazard and not on a putting green.

Green Aerification

Neil and the SCC maintenance staff will be aerifying, topdressing, dragging & fertilizing the greens Monday, September 10. This will be an all day process. The course will not be closed but most holes will be unplayable during certain times. The maintenance staff will not stop progress to allow golfers to play. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

SCC Fescue

There have been many rules questions concerning the newly planted fescue. If your ball goes in the fescue, the following applies. Play the ball as it lies or declare ball unplayable (Rule 28). The fescue is not a hazard. If your ball is lost (Rule 27-1), you must replay the shot with a one stroke penalty. If you believe your ball may be lost in fescue, you can hit a provisional ball (Rule 27-2) to save time. If you have any rules questions, please feel free to contact Scott.

SCC Late Payment Policy

All statements are due upon receipt and are considered past due on the 20th of each month. A grace period will exist after the 20th until the end of that month. Those bills not paid by the end of the month will be assessed a \$25 late charge and considered 30 days past due. If the bill remains unpaid the following month, the bill will be considered 60 days past due and assessed \$50 in addition to the previous month's \$25 for a total of \$75. All club privileges will be revoked at that point. Membership termination and forfeiture of club stock, if applicable, will be enforced at 90 days past due.
