Golf Cart Usage Rules

SCC members are driving their golf carts in areas that are unacceptable. The maintenance staff placed ropes on the golf course to keep carts out of prohibited areas only to see members drive around the ropes and inside these areas. The SCC staff and Board understand that there are still many areas of improvement needed for the golf course. However, we do expect our members to obey the rules and improvement will come. Cart signage has been ordered to help direct members to proper areas. The ropes will come down. We realize they are an eyesore and they are not working very well either. Unfortunately, it has come to this. The Board has instructed that members who do not obey the cart usage rules be fined. The fine will be \$25 per occurrence. There will be warnings issued prior to fines. **Rules: 1 - Keep carts 30 yards from the green (look for signs). 2 - Use cart paths around greens and tee boxes. 3 - Cart path only on all par 3's. 4 - No carts in the fescue.** There is only one side of each green and tee box that has a cart path. We are asking you to use that side. The cart path is 6 feet wide. Please keep all four tires on the path. Our goal is not to fine anyone. Please let us know if you have any questions.

My name is Eric Plummer and I will be the head lifeguard for the summer of 2009. I have been a Red Cross Certified Lifeguard for 6 years and a YMCA swim instructor.

The following classes will be held by age group. The swim clinics will be \$50 per person and will include 8 classes for 45 min each. We will have 5-6 children per instructor depending on age group.

The group clinic dates are below:

For ages 7-12, from 8:00am-8:45am

Class 1 - May 26 – June 5 T-F

Class 2 - June 16th- June 26th T-F

For ages 3-6 from 9:00am-9:45am

Class 3 - May 26 – June 5 T-F

Class 4 - June 16th- June 26th T-F

For ages 13-up (adult) from 9:00am-9:45am

Class 5 - May 30th- August 1st this will be a Saturday only class, class will not meet on June 27th, and July 4th

There will also be private lessons offered 10:00am-10:30am and 10:30am-11:00am T-F each week, the price will be \$60 which will include 4 classes 30 min each. This will be on a first come first serve basis.

SCC POOL RULES

1. Hours of operation are posted in the monthly newsletter and will vary with special events and time of season.
2. All members and guests should use the sign-in book located at the table near the gated entrance.
3. Use of the pool is for members and out-of-town guests in accordance with the general rules.
4. Unsupervised children under 10 years of age are forbidden.
5. A lifeguard must be on duty to enter the swimming pool area.
6. Swim diapers are required for all children who are not toilet trained.
7. No person suffering from an open cut, skin lesion, disease or virus should use the pool.
8. Conversation should be limited with the Lifeguards on duty.
9. Pool toys should be made of plastic or rubber with no sharp edges.
10. Proper attire should be worn in the pool area. No cutoffs and gym shorts. Proper attire (swimsuit cover) should also be worn when entering the clubhouse from the pool area.
11. No glass is allowed at the pool.
12. All trash is expected to be disposed of properly.
13. Food service is available at the pool while the kitchen is open.
14. Thursday is In-Town Guest Day, with a fee of \$5.00 per guest payable in the pro shop. A maximum of 3 guests are allowed. The member is responsible for all fees incurred by the guest if not reconciled at the end of the day.
15. All soft drinks, sports drinks, and alcoholic beverages are to be purchased at the Club. Beverages cannot be brought into the pool area in private coolers. Some kids snacks and/or drinks are acceptable.

Observe all general and unspoken rules including but not limited to:

- Rambunctious behavior/ horseplay
- One person on the diving board and slide at a time
- No pushing/shoving
- No loitering after regular pool hours
- No running
- Other member privileges



The lead Lifeguard on duty has final safety authority in all situations and will close the pool when thunderstorms or lightening occur.
