SCC Late Payment Policy

All statements are due upon receipt and are considered past due on the 20th of each month. A grace period will exist after the 20th until the end of that month. Those bills not paid by the end of the month will be assessed a \$25 late charge and considered 30 days past due. If the bill remains unpaid the following month, the bill will be considered 60 days past due and assessed \$50 in addition to the previous month's \$25 for a total of \$75. All club privileges will be revoked at that point. Membership termination and forfeiture of club stock, if applicable, will be enforced at 90 days past due.

SCC Membership Classes

FULL MEMBER Stock Purchase Price \$500 with dues of \$130 per month with a meal requirement of \$20 per month.

SWIMMING POOL/TENNIS/SOCIAL MEMBER Membership Fee \$250 with dues of \$90 per month with a meal requirement of \$30 per month.

JUNIOR MEMBER Membership Fee \$300 with dues of \$100 per month with no meal requirement.

SOCIAL MEMBER Membership Fee \$175 with dues of \$60 per month with a meal requirement of \$30 per month.

NONRESIDENT MEMBER Membership Fee \$250 with dues of \$75 per month for residents of adjacent counties and dues of \$50 per month for residents of other counties or states.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP Stock Purchase Price \$500, with dues per individual member the same as other members depending on membership class. All charges will be billed to the corporation with a detail statement for each member.

Sunday afternoon has become a very busy time on our golf course. For this reason, the SCC staff requires Sunday tee times. There will be guidelines that have to be followed. Afternoon tee times will be scheduled on holes 1 & 10 from 12:45 pm - 2:15 pm. There will not be starting times from approximately 2:15 pm - 3:45 to allow for turns to each side. Juniors golfers 15 & under are not allowed to play until after 3:45 pm unless accompanied by an adult. Please contact Scott or Jimbo if you have any questions. Tee times are not required before 12:45 pm. However, please understand that you must make the turn before 12:45 pm. Tournaments will alter tee times.
