## Swimming pool hours of operation:

**Monday - Closed**

**Tuesday - Saturday 9:00 am - 9:00 pm**

**Sunday - 1:00 pm - 9:00 pm**

## Cabana hours of operation:

**Monday - Closed**

**Tuesday - Saturday 10:00 am - 8:00 pm**

**Sunday 1:00 pm - 8:00 pm**

(Cabana hours may be adjusted due to weather and member participation)

All children under the age of 12 **MUST** present their Cabana Ordering Card when ordering anything from the Cabana. Please email [Victoria@starkvillecc.org](mailto:Victoria@starkvillecc.org) to register to get your family a card. All Cabana Ordering Cards will be ready for pick up at the Cabana May 18th!!

There may be times where we are limited on lifeguard staff. Please make sure a responsible party is paying close attention to your non-swimming children.

Our Registration table will be set up at the South pool gate. Please make it a priority to register yourself and to get wristbands for all guests upon entering the pool deck.

## POOL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**All members are required to register at the south pool gate.** The lifeguard staff will have a list with all members (including children) to validate membership. If your name or child's name is not on the list, please inform the staff and the list will be updated. The guest policy will be strictly enforced and violations will result in a fine.

**Out-of-town guests** (guests from outside Oktibbeha county) will be allowed any time with a \$10 guest fee that must be charged to the member's account. No cash or checks will be accepted at the registration table. Anyone who is NOT a current member will be required to register at the south pool gate and acquire a daily guest armband. If any member notices a non-member at the pool that does not have an armband, please notify the SCC staff at the registration table.

**Babysitters:** (only 1) are allowed to bring only members' children to the pool when the parents are not available. Please email babysitters' names to Victoria at [victoria@starkvillecc.org](mailto:victoria@starkvillecc.org) in order for them to be added to the babysitter list. Please understand that these policies have been implemented to protect the SCC membership. **Parents: In order to prevent embarrassment, please make sure your teenage children are aware of the policies.** You are welcome to email Victoria if you have any questions.

The Starkville Country Club **IN TOWN guest policy** will be the same as previous seasons. Each member will be allowed to purchase a **maximum of 10 in town guest passes** for the season. Before Friday, June 21st, they will be \$10 each. These **passes are valid Tuesday through Friday (no weekends or holidays)**. After June 21st you can still buy passes for \$20 as long as you have not already bought the maximum of 10.

If interested in buying passes, please go to pro shop to purchase. Pool Passes will be available starting on Thursday, May 9th. You will receive printed passes that you will present at the gate when bringing a guest. **The lifeguards will be collecting the passes at gate. All in town guests must have a pass. No cash or checks will be accepted at the registration table, passes must be purchased in the pro shop.** The club will be strictly enforcing this policy to make sure our pool experience is enjoyable for every member.

**Each In Town Guest is limited to 3 visits per season.**

***In Town Guest passes will be available for purchase from the pro shop on Thursday, May 9th 2024***

# POOL RULES

Here are our Pool Rules. Please help our lifeguards enforce these rules.

1. Swim diapers are required for all children who are not potty-trained.
2. All members are required to register at the south pool gate.
3. All children under 12 years of age must be supervised by a parent/guardian.
4. No person suffering from an open cut, skin lesion, contagious disease or virus should use the pool.
5. Conversation with lifeguards on duty should be limited.
6. Pool toys should be made of plastic or rubber with no sharp edges.
7. Proper attire should be worn in the pool. No cutoffs or gym shorts. Proper attire (swimsuit cover up and shoes) should also be worn when entering the clubhouse from the pool area.
8. No glass is allowed at the pool.
9. All trash should be disposed of properly. Please help keep the pool deck and patio trash free.
10. All soft drinks, sports drinks and alcoholic beverages are to be purchased at the club. Beverages cannot be brought into the pool area in private coolers.
11. No Medium or Large inflatable/rafts are allowed in the pool area. Noodles and children's rings are allowed.
12. No hard footballs/balls are allowed in the pool. Soft, water balls are allowed as long as they do not interfere with other members and families.

**Observe all general and common sense rules including but not limited to:  
No rambunctious behavior or horseplay  
one person on the diving board and slide at a time no pushing or shoving no  
loitering after pool hours no running**
